	Pesticide Environmental Trust Fund is created. Moneys appropriated to,

•	as directed by the Board, distribute the moneys in this Fund as follows:	
<u>(1)</u>	Two and one-half percent (2.5%) of the Fund to North Carolina State

<u>(2)</u>	Two and one-half percent (2.5%) of the Fund to East Carolina

	of Toxicology, to establish and maintain an agromedicine specialist

4	Sec. 2. G.S. 143-422 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
5	"(b1) In addition to the registration fee pursuant to subsection (b) of this section,
6	the applicant shall pay an annual assessment of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each brand or
7	grade of pesticide registered. The assessments shall be deposited in the Pesticide
8	Environmental Trust Fund under G.S. 143-441A."
9	Sec. 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 1994, and applies to all
10	applicants for registration under G.S. 143-442 who register pesticides on or after that
11	date.
