### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

# 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR PAMLICO COUNTY WATER 3 EROSION CONTROL PROJECT AND TO DRAW DOWN FEDERAL FUNDS 4 FOR THIS PROJECT.

5 Whereas, the Corps of Engineers project in the Town of Oriental, Pamlico 6 County, provides for installation of approximately 1,000 feet of steel bulkhead to 7 protect a section of South Avenue in the Town of Oriental from being undermined by 8 water erosion, and also provides for the installation of an asphalt sidewalk and a 9 hand/guard rail along the bulkhead; and

10 Whereas, if the State does not appropriate matching funds for this project, 11 then over \$400,000 in federal funds will not be available; Now, therefore,

12 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

13 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 14 Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Water Resources, the sum of 15 ninety-one thousand three hundred thirty-three dollars (\$91,333) for the 1994-95 fiscal 16 year to match federal funds for the Corps of Engineers bulkhead project in the Town of 17 Oriental.

18 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
