A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HARRIET'S HOUSE.
- 3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 4 Correction the sum of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal 5 year to support the programs at Harriet's House, a transitional home for female ex-6 offenders and their children. Harriet's House shall report quarterly to the Joint 7 Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations on the expenditure of State 8 appropriations and on the effectiveness of the program, including information on the 9 number of clients served and the number of clients who successfully complete the 10 Harriet's House program. 11
 - Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
