The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Soil and Water Conservation, Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the costs of North Carolina serving as host of the National Envirothon to be held in Asheville this year. The National Envirothon is a competitive, five-day program for high school students from across the United States that tests the students' knowledge of natural resources and cultivates a desire to learn about our environment.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
