Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Crime Control and Public Safety the sum of seventy-nine thousand three hundred fiftyseven dollars (\$79,357) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to provide additional resources to the Crime Prevention Division so that the Division may more effectively respond to demands for support in the areas of juvenile, violent, public housing, and inner-city community crime prevention.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
