A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN
2 RESOURCES TO ESTABLISH A STATE NUTRITION ASSISTANCE
3 PROGRAM.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7 Human Resources the sum of one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000)
8 for the 1994-95 fiscal year to establish a State Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) to
9 allow the six North Carolina food banks to purchase commodities that would be given
10 to SNAP-certified pantries across the State so as to provide families and children with
11 the nutrients they need. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

- 12 (1) \$1,000,000 to purchase the commodities; and
13 (2) \$200,000 for transporting, storing, and handling the commodities at
14 the food bank level.

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
