ENFORCEMENT SERVICES AND TO CHANGE REQUIREMENTS FOR
CREATION OF DISTRICTS COVERING THE ENTIRE UNINCORPORATED
AREA OF A COUNTY.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 153A-301(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
read:
"(10) Law Enforcement."
Sec. 2. G.S. 153A-302 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
"(e) Provision of Services on a Countywide Basis. – If the board of
commissioners is creating a service district which covers the entire unincorporated area
of the county, the board of commissioners is not required to make finding (2) in
subsection (a) of this section. If the entire unincorporated area of the county is to be included within a service district, the requirement of subsection (a) of this section that
included within a service district, the requirement of subsection (c) of this section that
each property be notified by mail does not apply if the board of commissioners publishes a notice of the proposal to establish the service district once a week for four
successive weeks prior to the date of the hearing."
Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
