AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO NE

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO NEW HANOVER COUNTY COMMUNITY ACTION, INC., FOR A COMMUNITY PRESCHOOL PROGRAM TO SERVE CHILDREN RESIDING IN PUBLIC HOUSING PROJECTS IN THE CITY OF WILMINGTON.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to New Hanover County Community Action, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be allocated to Crossroads of North Carolina, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, as grant funds for the implementation of a community preschool program, for children residing in public housing projects in the City of Wilmington, designed to break the cycle of intergenerational poverty and for the development of long-range plans for the continued operation and expansion of the project, including the creation of a private jobs program for the parents of the children enrolled in the community preschool. Any unallocated or unexpended funds remaining at the end of the fiscal year shall revert to the General Fund.

Sec. 2. By February 1, 1995, New Hanover County Community Action, Inc., and Crossroads of North Carolina, Inc., shall make a progress report to the General Assembly on the development of the community preschool project by submitting a written report to the Chairs of the House of Representatives and Senate Appropriations Committees and to the Fiscal Research Division.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
