2 AN ACT TO ALLOW ADDITIONAL RETROACTIVE MEMBERSHIP IN THE 3 NORTH CAROLINA FIREMEN'S AND RESCUE SQUAD WORKERS' 4

- PENSION FUND.
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - Section 1. G.S. 58-86-45(a) reads as rewritten:

7 Any fireman or rescue squad worker who is now eligible and is a member of "(a) a fire department or rescue squad chartered by the State of North Carolina and who has 8 not previously elected to become a member may make application through the board of 9 trustees for membership in the fund on or before March 31, 1987. 1995. The person 10 shall make a lump sum payment of five dollars (\$5.00) per month retroactively to the 11 time he first became eligible to become a member, plus interest at an annual rate of 12 eight percent (8%), for each year of his retroactive payments. Upon making the lump 13 sum payment, the person shall be given credit for all prior service in the same manner as 14 if he had made application for membership at the time he first became eligible. Any 15 member who made application for membership subsequent to the time he was first 16 eligible and did not receive credit for prior service may receive credit for this prior 17 service upon lump sum payment of five dollars (\$5.00) per month retroactively to the 18 time he first became eligible, plus interest at an annual rate of eight percent (8%), for 19 20 each year of his retroactive payments. Upon making this lump sum payment, the date of membership shall be the same as if he had made application for membership at the 21 time he was first eligible. Any fireman or rescue squad worker who has applied for 22 prior service under this subsection shall have until October 1, 1989, 1995, to pay for this 23

- 1 prior service and, if this payment is not made by October 1, 1989, 1995, he shall not
- 2 receive credit for this service, except as provided in subsection (a1) of this section."
- 3 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
