February 22, 1993 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT ALL WORKERS IN ALL "NONREGISTERED" DAY 3 CARE THAT RECEIVES REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE STATE RECEIVE REGULARLY UPDATED PEDIATRIC CPR TRAINING. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Article 7 of Chapter 110 of the General Statutes is amended by 6 7 adding a new section to read: "§ 110-101.2. CPR Training in 'nonregistered' homes. 8 All day care workers who provide care in all those day care homes that are not 9 required to be registered under this Article but that receive State subsidies for child care, 10 including care provided by grandparents, aunts, uncles, step-grandparents, or greatgrandparents and in religious-sponsored nonregistered homes shall complete training in 12 pediatric CPR and shall have this training updated every two years. The Social Services 13 Commission shall, in its rule making, adopt a schedule for implementing this section." 14

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
