AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT ALL WORKERS IN ALL "NONREGISTERED" DAY

CARE THAT RECEIVES REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE STATE RECEIVE

REGULARLY UPDATED PEDIATRIC CPR TRAINING.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 7 of Chapter 110 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 110-101.1. CPR training in 'nonregistered' homes.

All day care workers who provide care in all those day care homes that are not required to be registered under this Article but that receive State subsidies for child care, including care provided by grandparents, aunts, uncles, step-grandparents, or great-grandparents and in religious-sponsored nonregistered homes shall complete training in pediatric CPR and shall have this training updated every two years. The Social Services Commission shall, in its rule making, adopt a schedule for implementing this section."

Sec. 2. The Division of Social Services, Department of Human Resources, shall direct the county department of social services in each county where access to pediatric CPR training is unavailable to provide this training so that others in that county may become qualified to do so.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
