1 AN ACT RECOMMENDED BY THE JUVENILE LAW STUDY COMMISSION
2 ADDING TRAINING SCHOOLS TO THE COMMITMENT OPTIONS WHEN
3 COMMITMENT OF A JUVENILE FOR THIRTY DAYS OR LESS IS
4 ORDERED.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. G.S. 7A-652(c) reads as rewritten:

8 "(c) In no event shall commitment of a delinquent juvenile be for a period of time
9 in excess of that period for which an adult could be committed for the same act. Any
10 juveniles committed for an offense for which an adult would be sentenced for 30 days
11 or less shall be assigned to a local detention home as defined by G.S. 7A-517(15) or a
12 regional home as defined by ~~G.S. 7A-517(26)~~ G.S. 7A-517(26), or the training school
13 system, in the discretion of the Division of Youth Services."

14 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993, and applies to
15 commitments ordered for offenses committed on or after that date.
