3	AGE	OF TWELVE IN THE BED OR CARGO AREA OF PICKUP TRUCKS.
4	The Gene	eral Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5		Section 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
6	section to read:	
7	" <u>§ 20-13</u>	5.2B. Transporting children under 12 years of age in pickup truck beds
8		prohibited; exceptions.
9	(a)	The driver of the vehicle shall insure that no child under the age of 12 years
10	of age is	transported in the bed of a pickup truck, or other vehicle having an open bed.
11	<u>(b)</u>	Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply when:
12		(1) The vehicle is being operated at a speed of 15 miles per hour or less;
13		(2) An adult is present in the open bed of the vehicle and is supervising
14		the child; or
15		(3) The child is secured or restrained by a seat belt manufactured in
16		compliance with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 208,
17		installed to support a load strength of not less than 5,000 pounds for
18		each belt, and of a type approved by the Commissioner.
19	<u>(c)</u>	The provisions of G.S. 20-135.2A(d)-(i) apply to this section."
20		Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
