A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RETIRED SENIOR VOLUNTEER
 PROGRAM (RSVP).
 Whereas, North Carolina has over 900,000 citizens 65 and older; and
 Whereas, older adults now comprise the fastest growing segment of North
 Carolina's population with North Carolina experiencing a growth rate of thirty-one
 percent (31%) for individuals 65 and older compared with a growth rate of thirteen
- 8 percent (13%) for North Carolina as a whole; and
- 9 Whereas, older citizens have contributed greatly to the economic 10 development of North Carolina and will continue to contribute because of their 11 increased numbers; and
- 12 Whereas, there is a need for more comprehensive State policies that 13 emphasize keeping these adults valuable, continuing members of the community; and
- Whereas, the Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP), established in 1971, provides a program that offers the older adults the opportunity to find meaningful ways to contribute their skills and wisdom to help meet the needs of their local communities; and
- 18 Whereas, there are currently 17 Retired Senior Volunteer Programs in the 19 following 25 counties in North Carolina: Buncombe, Cabarrus, Caldwell, Carteret, 20 Columbus, Cumberland, Davie, Durham, Forsyth, Guilford, Harnett, Haywood, 21 Henderson, Jackson, Madison, Mecklenburg, Moore, New Hanover, Orange, Surry, 22 Transylvania, Union, Wake, Wayne, and Yadkin; and
- 23 Whereas, federal funding for this program has not increased since 1975; and

- Whereas, there is currently no federal funding available to start new Retired 1 2 Senior Volunteer Programs; and
- 3 Whereas, there is a great need and demand for the Retired Senior Volunteer Programs from local areas; Now, therefore, 4
- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Aging, Department of Human Resources, the sum of three hundred thousand dollars 7 8 (\$300,000) for the 1993-94 fiscal year to fund Retired Senior Volunteer Programs 9 (RSVP), to be allocated as follows:

- (1) Two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) to fund new Retired Senior Volunteer Programs; and

- One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to fund existing Retired

- (2)Senior Volunteer Programs.

The program guidelines and standards for new programs shall be in 14 15 accordance with federal requirements for existing programs. The guidelines for the local matching funds shall also be in accordance with federal guidelines. 16

17 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
