9	a public housing facility shall be punished as a Class E felon. A
10	person sentenced under this subdivision must serve a mandatory term
11	of imprisonment of no less than two years, notwithstanding the
12	provisions of G.S. 90-95(h)(5) or any other law. The sentencing judge
13	may not suspend the mandatory two-year term of imprisonment or
14	place the person on probation for the mandatory two-year term of
15	imprisonment. During that time the prisoner is not eligible for early
16	parole or early release."
