- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. It shall be unlawful to have in one's possession or immediately 6 accessible to one's person a loaded firearm when such person is under the influence of 7 an impairing substance as defined by G.S. 20-4.01(14a).

8 Sec. 2. The fact that a person charged with violating this section is or has 9 been legally entitled to use alcohol or a drug is not a defense to a charge under this act.

10 Sec. 3. Violation of this act is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to 11 exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment not more than 60 days or both.

- 12 Sec. 4. This act shall apply to Wake County only.
- 13 Sec. 5. This act shall become effective October 1, 1993.
