The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 4 Section 1. G.S. 15A-245 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(c) Notwithstanding the provisions of Chapter 132 of the General Statutes, the 6 search warrant application, the search warrant, and their contents, shall not be disclosed by the issuing official, the clerk, or any other party, except in connection with service of the warrant as provided in G.S. 15A-252, until the search warrant has been returned in accordance with G.S. 15A-257 or for a period of 48 hours, whichever occurs first." 10 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective 30 days after ratification.

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
