## CHAPTER 147 HOUSE BILL 981

## AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR A VOLUNTARY PROGRAM FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF ORGANICALLY PRODUCED AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Part 3 of Article 1 of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

## "§ 106-22.3. Organic Production Program.

(a) <u>The Board of Agriculture may establish rules, standards, guidelines, and</u> policies for the establishment and implementation of a voluntary program for the certification of organically produced agricultural products.

(b) The Commissioner of Agriculture may enter into agreements with the United States Department of Agriculture and may apply for approval, accreditation, certification, or similar authority as may be necessary to comply with the requirements of the Organic Foods Production Act of 1990, Public Law 101-624."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
