A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT IT IS PERMISSIBLE TO PREPARE AND SERVE  
2 FOOD AND BEVERAGES IN A GAZEBO OR OTHER STRUCTURE  
3 LOCATED OVER NONNAVIGABLE WATERS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 113A-107 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

6 "(g) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, it is permissible to prepare and  
7 serve food and beverages in a facility such as a gazebo, dock, or porch, whether  
8 enclosed or not, located over nonnavigable waters, provided that the facility complies  
9 with health and building laws. For purposes of this subsection, 'nonnavigable waters'  
10 are those bodies of water that are partially enclosed and that have a depth at low tide of  
11 no more than 12 inches."

12 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
