A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AMEND THE CAMPAIGN LAWS TO ELIMINATE THE
2 DIFFERENCE IN POSTPRIMARY REPORTING BY NOMINEES AND
3 PRIMARY LOSERS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 163-278.9(a)(3) reads as rewritten:

7 "(3) Postprimary Report(s). – The treasurer of each candidate shall file a
8 report with the Board no later than the 30th day after the primary
9 election if the candidate was eliminated in the primary. If there is a
10 second primary, the treasurer shall file a report with the Board no later
11 than the 30th day after the second primary election if the candidate
12 was eliminated in the second primary. 60th day before the general
13 election. An individual who was defeated in a primary election is a
14 candidate for purposes of the reporting required by this subdivision."

15 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective January 1, 1995, and applies to all
16 primaries and elections occurring on or after that date.
