- 5 TAX DUE THE CITY BY TWO PUBLIC UTILITIES.
- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 389 of Chapter 16 of the Private Laws of 1923 is amended 7 by adding the following immediately before the period at the end: "; provided, however, 8 the imposition and payment of taxes, authorized by this section, on and by Carolina 9 Power & Light Company and Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc., their 10 successors or assigns, shall be governed by that Agreement dated the 24th day of May 11 1994, by and among the City of Asheville, Carolina Power & Light Company, and 12 Public Service Company of North Carolina, Inc., which Agreement was approved and 13 authorized to be executed by the Asheville City Council by its Resolution Number 96-14 94, and which Agreement is spread upon the official minutes of the City Council of the 15 same date". 16

17 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
