14 United States Naval Investigative Service special agents; 15 **(4)** Drug Enforcement Administration special agents; 16 (5) United States Customs Service officers; 17 (6) **(7)** United States Postal Service inspectors: 18 Internal Revenue Service special agents; 19 (8) United States Marshals Service marshals and deputies; 20 (9) United States Forest Service officers: 21 (10)22 (11)National Park Service officers; and United States Fish and Wildlife Service officers; and 23 (12)Immigration and Naturalization Service agents." 24 (13)
