The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 18B-302 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b) of this section, malt beverages may "(i) be sold or given to, and malt beverages may be purchased or possessed by a person 18 years of age or older if that person is: A member of the armed forces of the United States; (1) A full-time student at a college or community college in this State; or (2) A high school graduate and works 40 or more hours-per-week as an (3) employee of a business in this State." Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1993, and applies to all acts decriminalized by this act occurring on or after that date.
