A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO PERMIT THE INSPECTION OF OSTRICHES AND OTHER RATITES UNDER THE MEAT INSPECTION ACT.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  Section 1. Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is amended by adding the following new Article:  "ARTICLE 491.

The Commissioner may establish a fee at an hourly rate to be paid by the owner, proprietor, or operator of each slaughtering, meat-canning, salting, packing, rendering, or similar establishment for the purpose of defraying the expenses incurred in the inspection of ostriches and other ratites as required by Article 49B of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes."	

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1993.
