Section 1. Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read:

"ARTICLE 6F.
"TOLL ROADS.

"§ 136-89.80. Authority of county commissioners with regard to toll roads.

- (a) Upon a petition of ten percent (10%) of the citizens of the county, or upon its own motion, the Board of County Commissioners, after consultation with the Department of Transportation, and after a public hearing, may designate a proposed highway within the county as suitable as a toll road.
- (b) After the highway has been designated as suitable as a toll road, the citizens of the county in which the toll road is to be established shall vote, in a binding referendum, on the question of the establishment of that toll road. If the referendum results in a majority vote in favor of the establishment of the toll road, then the Department of Transportation shall prepare the plans for, and the Board of Transportation shall approve, within one year, as part of the Transportation Improvement Program, the required construction to create the toll road.
- 21 (c) For a proposed highway that crosses several counties, the Boards of County
 22 Commissioners and the voters of each of the counties through which the highway will
 23 pass shall approve the establishment of the toll road before any part of the highway is

Sec. 2. Prior to the construction of any toll road in North Carolina, the Department of Transportation shall submit to the General Assembly the legislation required to create a toll road authority to collect and distribute the tolls on the particular toll road.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective January 1, 1994.
