## BILL SUMMARY:

CLEAN WATER BOND BILL "To authorize the issuance of one hundred twenty million dollars in general obligation bonds of the state, subject to a vote of the qualified voters of the state, to provide funds through grants, revolving loans, and loans to local government units for water supply systems, wastewater collection systems and wastewater treatment works." \$20,000,000 is to be used for the same funds as funds used in the Clean Water Revolving Loan and Grant Fund. \$100,000,000 of the proceeds is to be used for loans to local governments.
