ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: No fiscal impact because: (1) migratory fowl hunting season is only 2 months--December and January. The Commission can adjust wildlife officers shift schedules in eastern districts to ensure coverage of Sunday without an increase in staff or man-hours and (2) the bill exempts the taking of migratory waterfowl on Sunday from current statutes that require criminal charges for hunting on Sunday.
