**BILL SUMMARY:** The proposed act makes the following changes to some of the fees set forth in Chapter 161, Article One, of the General Statutes governing the duties of Register of Deeds:

(1) Increases the fee for registering or filing any instrument in general by \$1.00.
(2) Eliminates the \$5.00 cancellation fee for deeds of trust and/or mortgages, and increases the registration fee for filing the first page by \$5.00.
(3) Increases the fee for probating all instruments by \$1.00.
