The title fee was last raised in 1989 from \$5 to \$35. The additional revenues were dedicated to the Highway Trust Fund, to be used for highway construction projects specified in the legislation.

EXPENDITURES Any reduction in Highway Trust Fund revenues will impact the 7-year Transportation Improvement Program, or TIP. A \$27 million revenue loss will impact the recently announced Transportation 2001 Program which accelerates many Trust Fund and other TIP construction projects; many projects scheduled in the 1994 TIP will have to be delayed unless the loss in state funds is offset by an increase in Federal funds. The number and location of those projects will be determined by the Board of Transportation.

POSITIONS: None

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY: The revenue loss was determined using an estimate for FY 1994-95 of 1.8 million title transfers. Expected growth is based on population growth of 1% per year.
