1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION TO
3	STUDY THE PROLIFERATION AND CRIMINAL USE OF WEAPONS IN
4	NORTH CAROLINA.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission is authorized to study:
7	(1) The types and sources of weapons that are used in crimes in North
8	Carolina;
9	(2) The scope of municipal authority to regulate the possession of all types
10	of firearms;
11	(3) The feasibility, cost, and effectiveness of establishing a safety
12	licensing system for possession of firearms;
13	(4) Restrictions on the sale of firearms and ammunition; and
14	(5) Any matter which can be demonstrated to reduce the criminal use of
15	firearms.
16	The State Bureau of Investigation and the Department of Crime Control and
17	Public Safety shall cooperate fully with this study if the Legislative Research
18	Commission undertakes it.
19	Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may make an interim report of
20	the results of this study, including legislative recommendations, to the 1994 Regular
21	Session of the 1993 General Assembly, and shall make a final report to the 1995
22	General Assembly.
23	Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
