A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ESTABLISH SUBSTANCE ABUSE
PROGRAMS IN CERTAIN PRISONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of one million five hundred forty-five thousand three hundred forty-five dollars (\$1,545,345) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to establish a Substance Abuse Program in each of five prisons located near urban areas throughout the State. Each Program shall be established in accordance with Article 6 of Chapter 143B of the General Statutes. The funds shall be allocated such that each prison shall provide substance abuse services to at least 100 inmates.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
