The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of thirteen million eight hundred fifteen thousand five hundred forty-eight dollars (\$13,815,548) for the 1994-95 fiscal year, for expansion funds for necessary positions and equipment needed to effect the crime prevention initiatives of the 1994-95 Extra Session of the 1993 General Assembly and for other purposes. These funds shall be allocated as follows:

- \$3,663,691 for court implementation of the Structured Sentencing Act; (1)
- \$6,120,932 for additional court infrastructure requirements for (2) equipment and data processing equipment;
- \$315,000 for laptop personal computers for those superior court judges (3) that do not now have them;
- \$576,381 for connection of remote magistrate offices to court (4) information system;
- \$1,418,962 for the district attorney and public defender case (5) management system expansion;
- \$375,047 for the court information system for additional support 23 (6) 24 personnel;
