February 15, 1994 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO PROVIDE GRANTS TO SHERIFFS' DEPARTMENTS OR OTHER LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR DRUG PURCHASES. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. (a) There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Justice the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year to be used to provide grants to sheriffs' departments or other appropriate local law enforcement agencies for the purchase of controlled substances in drug investigations. To the extent allowed by law, if any grant funds used to purchase drugs are (b) recovered by State law enforcement officials, the monies shall be repaid to the Department of Justice to be used for future grants. Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
