SENATE BILL 165

Short Title: SBI Agents Salaries.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE SBI FIELD AGENTS THE SAME SALARY BENEFITS AS HIGHWAY PATROL MEMBERS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 114-13 reads as rewritten:

"§ 114-13. Director of the Bureau; personnel.

(a) The Attorney General shall appoint a Director of the Bureau of Investigation, who shall serve at the will of the Attorney General, and whose salary shall be fixed by the Department of Administration under G.S. 143-36 et seq. He may further appoint a sufficient number of assistants and stenographic and clerical help, who shall be competent and qualified to do the work of the Bureau. The salaries of such assistants shall be fixed by the Department of Administration under G.S. 143-36 et seq. The salaries of clerical and stenographic help shall be the same as now provided for similar employees in other State departments and bureaus.

(b) Effective July 1, 1994, and in each year thereafter, all State Bureau of Investigation agents whose principal duties are in the field shall be granted a salary increase of five percent (5%). This subsection does not apply to the Director or any Assistant Director.

Sec. 2 There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Justice for the 1994-95 fiscal year the sum of five hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$575,000) to implement this act.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
