A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE GOVERNOR'S ONE ON ONE
2 PROGRAM.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
6 Human Resources, Division of Youth Services, the sum of one million one hundred
7 fifty thousand dollars (\$1,150,000) for the 1994-95 fiscal year for the Governor's One
8 on One Program, which is designed to match at-risk children with adult mentors. These
9 funds shall be to increase the funding for each of the existing programs and to provide
10 funding for new programs to bring the number of programs up to at least a total of 65
11 programs at funding levels of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000) for each full-time
12 program, fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) for each half-time program, and sixty
13 thousand dollars (\$60,000) for each double program.

14 Sec. 1.1. In order to assess the performance of the Governor's One on One
15 Program, an annual evaluation shall be conducted by the Office of Policy Development
16 and Research of the Department of Human Resources. The results of the evaluation
17 shall be submitted to the State Auditor for further review and comment. The State
18 Auditor shall transmit the evaluation along with any comments to the Joint Legislative
19 Commission on Governmental Operations no later than October 1 of each year covering
20 the program for the prior fiscal year. In conducting the evaluation, among other things,
21 the focus shall be on directing youth toward long-term positive and productive
22 noncriminal behavior. The review shall be qualitative and quantitative.

23 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1994.
