5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Article 22A of Chapter 163 of the General Statutes is amended by
7	adding a new section to read:
8	" <u>§ 163-278.7A. Gifts from federal political committees.</u>
9	It shall be permissible for a federal candidate's committee or a Federal Political
10	Action Committee, as defined by the Federal Election Campaign Act and regulations
11	adopted pursuant thereto, to make contributions to a North Carolina political committee
12	registered under this Article with the State Board of Elections or a county board of
13	elections, provided that the contributing committee:
14	(1) Is registered with the State Board of Elections consistent with the
15	provisions of this Article;
16	(2) Complies with reporting requirements specified by the State Board of
17	Elections; and
18	(3) Appoints an assistant or deputy treasurer who is a resident of North
19	Carolina and stipulates to the State Board of Elections that the

1	designated in-State resident assistant or deputy treasurer shall be
2	authorized to produce whatever records reflecting political activity in
3	North Carolina the State Board of Elections deems necessary."
4	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
