G.S. 105-113.17 reads as rewritten: "§ 105-113.17. Identification of dispensers, dispensers; sale of loose cigarettes prohibited. Dispensers. – Each vending machine that dispenses cigarettes must be marked to identify its owner in the manner required by the Secretary. Prohibition. – It is unlawful to sell loose, unpacked cigarettes." Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995, and applies to offenses occurring on or after that date.
