H 1 **HOUSE BILL 338** Short Title: Inspect Seat Belts. (Public) Sponsors: Representative Beall. Referred to: Transportation. March 2, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT SEAT BELTS WILL BE INSPECTED AS PART OF THE ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 20-183.3(a) reads as rewritten: Safety. – A safety inspection of a motor vehicle consists of an inspection of the following equipment to determine if the vehicle has the equipment required by Part 9 of Article 3 of this Chapter and if the equipment is in a safe operating condition: Brakes, as required by G.S. 20-124. (1) Lights, as required by G.S. 20-129 or G.S. 20-129.1. (2) Horn, as required by G.S. 20-125(a). (3) Steering mechanism, as required by G.S. 20-123.1. (4) Windows and windshield wipers, as required by G.S. 20-127. (5) Directional signals, as required by G.S. 20-125.1. (6) Tires, as required by G.S. 20-122.1. **(7)** Mirrors, as required by G.S. 20-126. (8) Exhaust system, as required by G.S. 20-128. For a vehicle that is subject (9) to an emissions inspection in addition to a safety inspection, a visual inspection of the vehicle's emission-control devices is included in the

emissions inspection rather than the safety inspection.
