A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE LEGISLATIVE RESEARCH COMMISSION SHALL STUDY MAKING SEAT BELTS AND AIR BAG INSPECTIONS A PART OF THE ANNUAL MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission shall study the inspection of seat belts and air bags as part of the annual vehicle safety inspections.

Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may submit an interim report to the 1996 Regular Session of the 1995 General Assembly. The Legislative Research Commission shall submit a final report of its recommendations and legislative proposals to the 1997 General Assembly.

Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Legislative Services Commission the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for use by the Legislative Research Commission in conducting the study authorized by Section 1 of this act.

Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
