1 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PUNISHMENT FOR THE OFFENSE OF COMMON-
2 LAW ROBBERY.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. G.S. 14-87.1 reads as rewritten:

6 "**§ 14-87.1. Punishment for common-law robbery.**

7 Robbery as defined at common law, other than robbery with a firearm or other
8 dangerous weapon as defined by G.S. 14-87, shall be punishable as a ~~Class G~~ Class F
9 felony."

10 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995, and applies to offenses
11 committed on or after that date.
