16 17 Section 1. Effective July 1, 1995, the Department of Human Resources shall increase the Adult Developmental Activity Program (ADAP) reimbursement rate to seventy percent (70%) of total cost.

- Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of five million four hundred thousand dollars (\$5,400,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of five million four hundred thousand dollars (\$5,400,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year, to implement Section 1 of this act.
- Sec. 3. The funds appropriated in this act shall not be used for equalization. The Department of Human Resources shall not charge any administrative fee to implement this act or to provide ADAP services or reimbursements.
 - Sec. 4. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
