6	Section 1. G.S. 95-107 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 95-107. Assessment and collection of fees; certificates of safe operation.
8	The assessment of the fees pursuant to this Article shall be made against the owner or
9	operator of such equipment and shall-may be collected at the time of inspection.
10	Certificates of safe operation shall-may be withheld by the Department of Labor until
11	such time as the assessed fees are collected."
12	Sec. 2. G.S. 95-110.5(18) reads as rewritten:
13	"(18) To require that any device or equipment subject to the provisions of this
14	Article which has been out-of-service and not continuously maintained
15	for one or more years shall not be returned to service without first
16	complying with all rules and regulations governing new existing
17	installations; and".
18	Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
