2	AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CITY OF GASTONIA TO MAKE CERTAIN
3	ASSESSMENTS OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. The Charter of the City of Gastonia, being Chapter 557 of the
6	Session Laws of 1991, is amended by adding a new section to read:
7	"Sec. 6.3A. Public Improvements Outside the City Limits.
8	In exercising the authority granted under Article 16 of Chapter 160A of the General
9	Statutes to extend and operate public enterprises outside the corporate limits, the City
10	Council shall specially assess all or part of the costs of constructing, reconstructing,
11	extending, building, or improving water supply and distribution systems or sewage
12	collection and disposal systems or both such systems or any part thereof, outside the
13	corporate limits of the City against property benefited therefrom; provided, however, no
14	special assessment shall be levied unless and until a valid petition for such improvements
15	has been submitted to the City by the owners of the property affected. In order to be
16	valid, the petition must be signed by at least a majority in number of the owners of
17	property to be assessed, who must represent at least a majority of all of the lineal fee of
18	frontage of the lands abutting the water or sewer improvement. Special assessments
19	levied pursuant to this section shall be levied and collected in the same way and under the

- 1 same authority and procedures as special assessments levied and collected by the City
- 2 upon property within the corporate limits."
- 3 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
