2	AN ACT TO CREATE A DRUG-FREE PUBLIC HOUSING ZONE BY PROVIDING
3	AN ENHANCED PENALTY FOR DRUG OFFENSES NEAR PUBLIC HOUSING
4	IN THE CITY OF NEW BERN.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 90-95(e) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"(10) Any person 21 years of age or older who commits an offense under G.S.
8	90-95(a)(1) on property owned, leased, or managed by a housing
9	authority (as defined in G.S. 157-3) or within 300 feet of the boundary
10	of real property owned, leased, or managed by a housing authority shall
11	be punished as a Class E felon. For purposes of this subdivision, the
12	transfer of less than five grams of marijuana for no remuneration shall
13	not constitute a delivery in violation of G.S. 90-95(a)(1)."
14	Sec. 2. This act applies only to the City of New Bern.
15	Sec. 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995, and applies to acts
16	committed on or after that date.
