A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT THE SITE OF THE 3 NORTH CAROLINA INDIAN CULTURAL CENTER. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of one hundred ninety-five thousand dollars (\$195,000) for the 6 7 1995-96 fiscal year for improvements on the site of the North Carolina Indian Cultural 8 Center, to be allocated as follows: 9 \$100,000 for the historic preservation of the Henry Berry Lowry House (1) and for the purchase of household furnishings and artifacts, to be 10 matched by \$50,000 in private sector funds; 11 \$40,000 for cleanup of the Lumber River and lake at the Cultural Center 12 (2) site, and for the design and construction of river walks at the site; 13 \$35,000 for security and maintenance of the grounds, and for upgrade of 14 (3) the swimming pool and amphitheater; and 15 \$20,000 for a traveling children's exhibit, which will combine an (4) 16 interpretation of North Carolina Indian history from prehistory to 17 modern times. 18

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
