The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 160A-20 is amended by adding a new subsection to read: "(b1) This section applies only to contracts that obligate the unit of local government over the full term of the contract, including periods that may be added to the original term through the exercise of options to renew or extend, for no more than three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000)." Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995, and applies to contracts
