A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT NONPROFIT BARBER SCHOOLS HAVE ONE INSTRUCTOR FOR EVERY TWENTY STUDENTS.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  Section 1. G.S. 86A-22(2) reads as rewritten:	
"(2)	Each school shall have at least two instructors, instructors, except that schools that are nonprofit educational institutions with a curriculum and continuing education support system established with a State university or community college shall have at least one instructor for every 20 enrolled students, provided the one instructor may not conduct classroom lectures and study periods, or lectures and demonstrations on practical work, during the same time the one instructor is providing students with supervised practice in barbering. Each instructor must

hold a valid instructor's certificate issued by the Board."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
