A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATES FOR
SUPPORTERS OF THE OLYMPIC GAMES.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
Section 1. G.S. 20-79.4(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision that reads:
"(17a) Olympic Games. – Issuable to the registered owner of a motor vehicle in
accordance with G.S. 20-81.12. The plate may bear a phrase or insignia
representing the Olympic Games."
Sec. 2. G.S. 20-79.7(a) reads as rewritten:
"(a) Fees. – Upon request, the Division shall provide and issue free of charge one
registration plate to a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor, a 100% disabled
veteran, and an ex-prisoner of war. All other special registration plates are subject to the
regular motor vehicle registration fee in G.S. 20-87 or G.S. 20-88 plus an additional fee
in the following amount:

Sec. 3. G.S. 20-79.7(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) Distribution of Fees. – The Special Registration Plate Account and the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account are established within the Highway Fund. The Division must credit the additional fee imposed for the special registration plates listed in subsection (a) among the Special Registration Plate Account (SRPA), the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account (CCAPA), and the Recreation and Natural Heritage Trust Fund (RNHTF), which is established under G.S. 113-77.7, as follows:

Sec. 4. G.S. 20-79.7 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

"(<u>b4</u>) Olympic Games. – The Division must receive 300 or more applications for an Olympic Games plate before the plate may be developed. The Division shall transfer quarterly the money in the Collegiate and Cultural Attraction Plate Account derived from the sale of Olympic Games plates to the N.C. Health and Fitness Foundation, Inc., which will divide the funds:

- (1) Fifty percent (50%) to the U.S. Olympic Committee to assist in training olympic athletes;
- (2) Twenty-five percent (25%) to North Carolina Amateur Sports to assist with administration of the State Games of North Carolina; and
- (3) Twenty-five percent (25%) to the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness and Health to support local fitness council development throughout North Carolina."
- Sec. 5. This act is effective upon ratification.
