A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EXPANSION OF SUMMIT HOUSE SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Correction the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for the expansion of services provided by Summit House, a community-based residential alternative to incarceration for mothers and pregnant women convicted of nonviolent crimes with programs based in Greensboro and Mecklenburg and Wake Counties.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
