The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 143-166.13(b) reads as rewritten: The following persons are entitled to benefits under this Article regardless of "(b) whether they are subject to the Criminal Justice Training and Standards Act: Driver License Examiners injured by accident arising out of and in the (1) course of giving a road test, Division of Motor Vehicles, Department of Transportation. <u>(2)</u> Employees injured by a direct and deliberate act of an inmate or an individual acting on behalf of an inmate, or while performing supervisory duties over inmates which place the employee at risk of such injury, Department of Correction." Sec. 2. This act is effective July 1, 1996, and applies to injuries occurring on
